DESIRED TRAITS

Candidates for the UGC should have the following traits:

- Willingness to model the Mission and Values, honor the Ritual, and adhere to the Code of Conduct
- Strong interpersonal communication skills
- A chapter or campus leader
- A desire to provide service to Delta Tau Delta beyond his own chapter

ACADEMIC REQUIREMENTS

The Fraternity's Constitution requires all members of the UGC:

- Be a full-time student
- Be in good standing at his host institution

These requirements must be satisfied at the time of appointment and at all times during the term of service. A detailed description of the requirements in found in Article VI, Part B of the *Constitution* and in Article XV of the *Bylaws*.

EXPECTATIONS

Members of the UGC attend regularly scheduled Undergraduate Council meetings. In addition, UGC members will serve on one other Arch Chapter standing committee. UGC members are expected to attend a regional conference each year during their term of service.

EXPENSES

The Fraternity's General Fund covers the travel, lodging and food expenses of UGC members attending scheduled Undergraduate Council meetings. Expenses to attend regional conferences are typically the responsibility of the UGC member or his home chapter.
