BIOGRAPHY

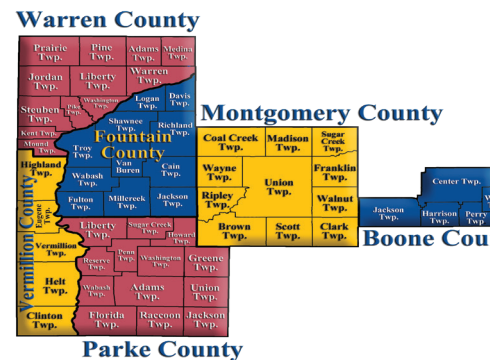
State Sen. Phil Boots has represented Hoosiers in west central Indiana at the Statehouse since he was elected in 2006. Boots represents Senate District 23, which includes all of Fountain, Montgomery, Parke, Vermillion and Warren counties and a portion of Boone County.

Boots is Chair of the Senate Committee on Pensions and Labor as well as a member of the Senate Committees on Appropriations; Homeland Security and Transportation; Public Policy; and Veterans Affairs and the Military.

Outside the Senate, he is the owner and operator of Boots Bros. Oil Company in Crawfordsville and president of Sagamore News Media, which publishes The Paper of Montgomery County, The Times of Noblesville, Sheridan News and The Weekly.

He attended Milligan College in Tennessee as well as Wabash College. He also served in the 1st Cavalry Division in the United States Army.

Boots has been named Outstanding State Senator by the Indiana Retired Teachers Association and Small Business Champion by the Indiana Chamber of Commerce.
