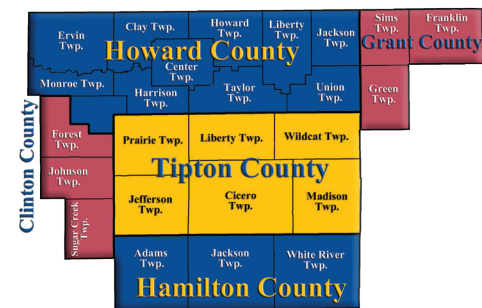
BIOGRAPHY
