7 The IAFP's Research Day Committee currently consists of four IAFP members from residency  
8 programs across the state. Additional faculty and Academy leaders assist with abstract judging. The  
9 committee has been active in its email group during the planning stages for the 2022 Research Day.

11 2022's event took place on Thursday, May 19 at the Ritz Charles event center in Carmel, with about  
12 100 family medicine residents and residency program faculty in attendance. For this event, we  
13 received an unprecedented total of 59 abstracts from 11 residency programs across the state. This is a  
14 much higher number than in previous years. \$1,800 in prize money was distributed at the end of the  
15 day.

17 In addition to the usual mixture of original research presentations, case presentations, and posters, the  
18 event featured the second annual Leadership Development Seminar that was planned and supported  
19 by leaders from the IAFP Foundation including Jason Marker, MD, and our committee chair, Gerald  
20 Morris, MD. The event was generally well reviewed. We plan to continue the Leadership Development  
21 Seminar at future Research Days.

23 In the coming months we will plan 2023's event, which will take place on Thursday, May 18th. The  
24 location will again be the Ritz Charles in Carmel. In 2023, we plan to make some changes to allow  
25 more residents to present their research, assuming that the number of submitted abstracts will be  
26 higher than in previous years due to the increased number of residency programs in the state.
